

Adding a custom SMS provider – Dolphin SMS

- Navigate to your virtual servers Comms Tab
- Select SMS Settings
- Select the Custom option
- Now select Generic HTTP(s) SMS Plugin



Adding a custom SMS provider – Dolphin SMS

- Now click Apply
 - Note - Test sms will not work until settings applied

- Perform a test
 - Note – Mobile number must be in international format
e.g. 077889955223 becomes 4177889955223
